

PANEL I - Regulation of property valuers: national versus global, is it compatible?



Danijela Ilic, FRICS, REV, Licence 025, NAVS President

Danijela is qualified property valuer holding Recognized European Valuer professional mark with over 35 years of experience in property industry, out of which over of 18 years of experience in property valuation in Serbia.

In 2008 she has set up valuation company Operational Center of Asset Valuers which has dealt with major real estate development projects in Serbia including important government projects such as converting surplus military properties into civil uses, viability studies for new uses of brownfield locations and others.

As of 2016, she is freelance consultant and counselor on numerous issues regarding real estate in Serbia. She is founder and President of National Association of Valuers of Serbia. Under her leadership, NAVS became a member of TEGoVA in 2011 and a REV awarding member of TEGoVA in 2012. She has participated in translation of EVS and IVS into Serbian language as of 2007. Danijela is currently a member of the Board of The European Group of Valuers' Associations (TEGoVA) and a member of TEGoVA's European Valuation Practice and Methodology Board and also President of the EBVSC Committee.



Dejan Hadzic, Head of Insurance and Real Estate Unit, Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Serbia, Member of the Professional Board

During his professional career, he has worked both in private and governmental sector, on responsible managerial positions.

Dejan has been a member of a various working groups (e.g. for preparation of numerous of laws), commissions (e.g. in employment process, in consultant selection process, Certification Exam Committee for brokers and agents in insurance, Certification Exam Committee for actuaries), teams (e.g. took part in privatization process of the insurance company DDOR Novi Sad) and expert bodies (e.g. member of the Professional Board), he has participated in creation of legislation (laws and bylaws – field of insurance, banking, financial leasing, foreign exchange, mortgage, real estate valuers) and internal regulation, in creation of new type of products (voluntary pension insurance), in establishing of the voluntary pension fund management company, he was representative of shareholder (DDOR Novi Sad, Vojvođanska banka, Republic of Serbia) in different Shareholders Assemblies. Also, he was lecturer in the in-house seminars (field of finance, securities and securities market) for preparation of the professional exam for insurance brokerage and/or agency services and in the CPD seminars for bankruptcy managers.

Ognjen Rogacev, MRICS, REV, Licence 035

Ognjen Rogačev is member of Professional Board for licensing real estate appraisers at the Ministry of Finance, Republic of Serbia. 
